This marker is found at each trailhead. It tells you the type of vehicle permitted, trail number, and degree of difficulty.

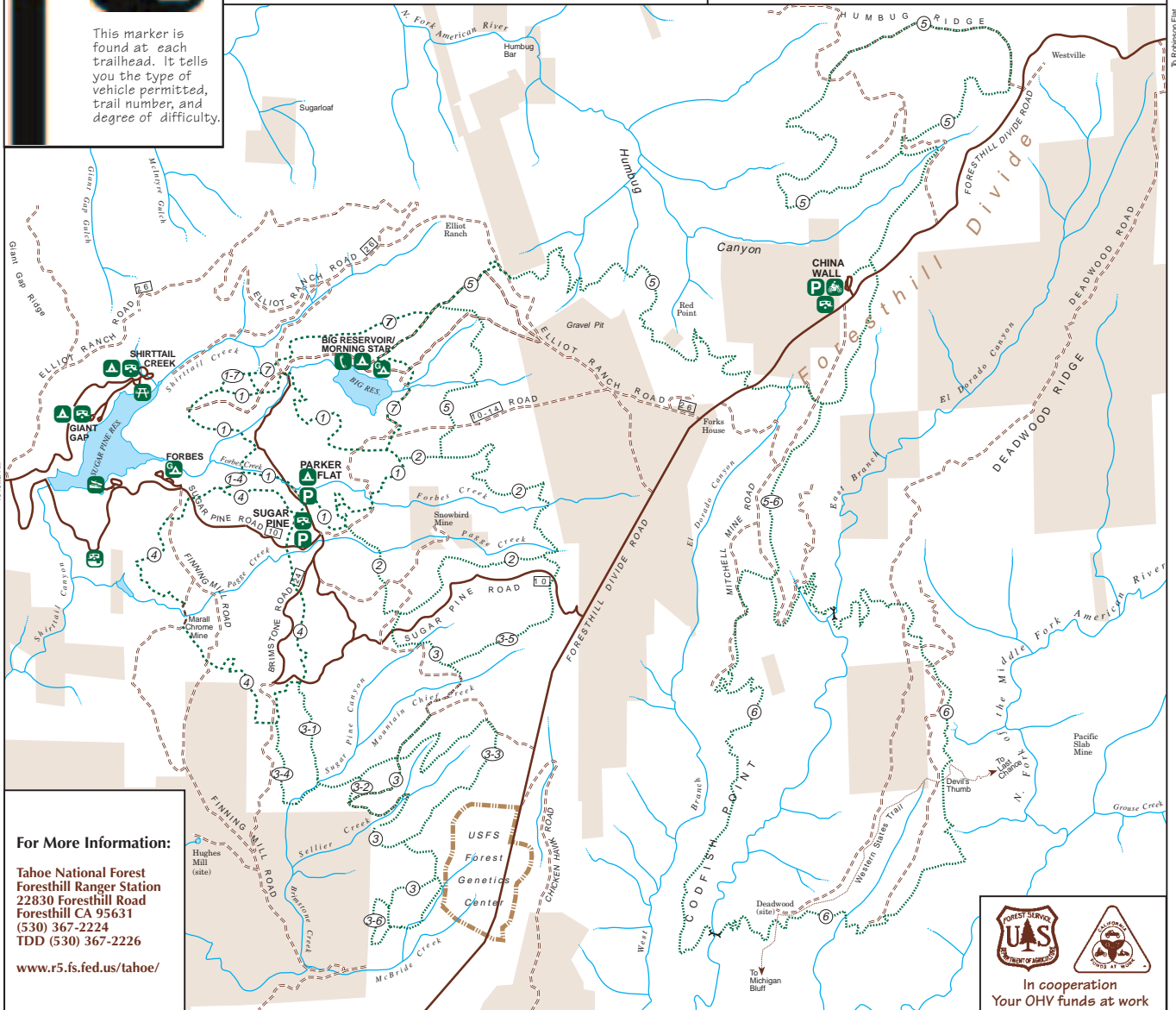
